ACDi Restriction of Hazardous Substances 3 (ROHS3) Directive 2015/863 Declaration

Restriction of Hazardous Substances 3 (ROHS3) directive 2015/863 adds four new chemicals (listed below) to the original restricted list of six substances. ACDi declares that its internal manufacturing processes are ROHS3 compliant.

- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): < 1000 ppm
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): < 1000 ppm
- **Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)**: < 1000 ppm
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): < 1000 ppm

ACDi has surveyed its printed circuit board vendors and they declare that they are also ROHS3 compliant, as long as the material specified by the customer's documentation is ROHS3 compliant.

ACDi purchases other material to the customer's approved vendor list (AVL). As this AVL is controlled by our customer, we cannot declare that the material purchased from this AVL is ROHS3 compliant. However, ACDi can aid our customers in determining whether their AVL is ROHS3 compliant and help identify potential substitute material.
